



## **CHEMISTRY INSTRUCTOR – PART-TIME POSITION**

### **JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Otero College is seeking a highly motivated and experienced individual to join the College as a Chemistry Instructor. The successful candidate will be responsible for designing and delivering high-quality education content that helps students develop the skills and knowledge necessary to succeed in Chemistry. Courses taught may include Chemistry 1111 General College Chemistry I with lab and Chemistry 1112 General College Chemistry II with lab.

Under the supervision of the Department Chair of Math and Science, the instructor will:

1. Plan and organize course materials, including syllabi, assignments, and student assessments.
2. Develop and implement effective instructional strategies that engage students and facilitate learning both in person and remote classroom environments.
3. Assess and evaluate student progress through assignments, exams, and other measures of performance and provide timely and constructive feedback to support student learning.
4. Collaborate with other faculty and staff to ensure program quality and a comprehensive educational experience for students.
5. Participate in faculty meetings, professional development opportunities, and other college events as needed and able.

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Master's degree and 18 graduate credit hours in Chemistry or a related field.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, including the ability to work effectively with diverse groups of students and colleagues.
- Familiarity with instructional technologies and online learning platforms.

### **PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Teaching experience at the post-secondary level.
- Willingness to teach a varied schedule including evenings, weekends, and summer hours.
- Demonstrate instructional quality (e.g., coursework or training in teaching methods or assessment of student learning).
- Evidence of flexibility in teaching methods to accommodate various learning styles.
- Prior teaching experience in secondary Chemistry.
- Excellent written and oral communication skills.
- Strong computer skills.
- Educational philosophy in alignment with that of a small rural, comprehensive Community College and enthusiasm for this type of environment and the aspirations of its people.
